

### High School and Middle School Supply List

All students will be using the Core organization system this year and are required to purchase spiral notebooks with holes that fit neatly into a three-ring binder. The spiral notebooks will need to be replaced as they are filled. In addition, all students need to have a 3" three ring binder and a set of Avery double pocket, notebook dividers.

#### **General Supply List**

- Music stand

- Folder

\*Students involved in more than one instrumental class only need one music stand and one music folder to hold everything.
